AREQUIPA

City of nearly one million inhabitants

Cultivated area is about 150 thousand Ha for production used domestically or exported

Crops: garlic, onion, potato, grapes, avocado, pomegranate, artichoke, corn, quinoa, rice, paprika peppers, alfalfa, prickley pear cactus for rearing the cochineal scale insect for production of red dye

Cattle: dairy cattle and southamerican camelids (alpacas, llamas, vicuna, guanaco)
